Annual Meeting RE-CAP

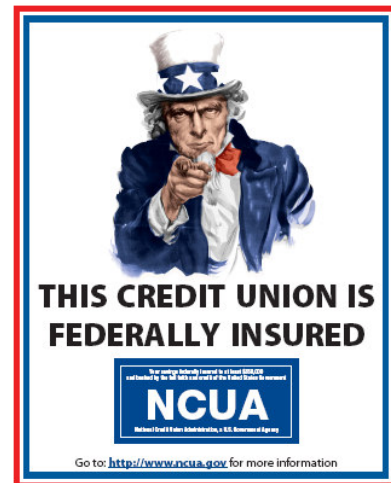

**NCUA Insurance Coverage
Increases from \$100,000 to \$250,000**

Last fall, with passage of the Emergency Economic Stabilization Act of 2008, Congress increased coverage of your savings insurance coverage from a maximum of \$100,000 to \$250,000 through the National Credit Union Administration (NCUA).

NCUA coverage is to credit unions what FDIC (Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation) coverage is to banks. Both funds are backed by the full faith and credit of the United States government.

Although this increased coverage is temporary until the end of 2009, expectations is that it will be extended or made permanent.
